- Summer program was located at Stanwood High and Twin City Elementary
- Summer meals were supported by four staff members
- August increased due to summer school program in August

Start of School Meals

- Sharp decline in participation returning to paid meals this year
- Federal & State legislators to discuss funding for free meals for all students
- If passed this will be a great help to our families and the District

- Supply chain issues continuing this year
 - Did not receive some items in every order placed
 - Requires substitutions to the menus
 - Message is on our web page about the supply chain issue so that parents are aware
- Food service team has become efficient and flexible with supply chain and labor shortages while still giving students healthy meal choices
- As students get familiar with using the point of sale again, we anticipate increased participation
