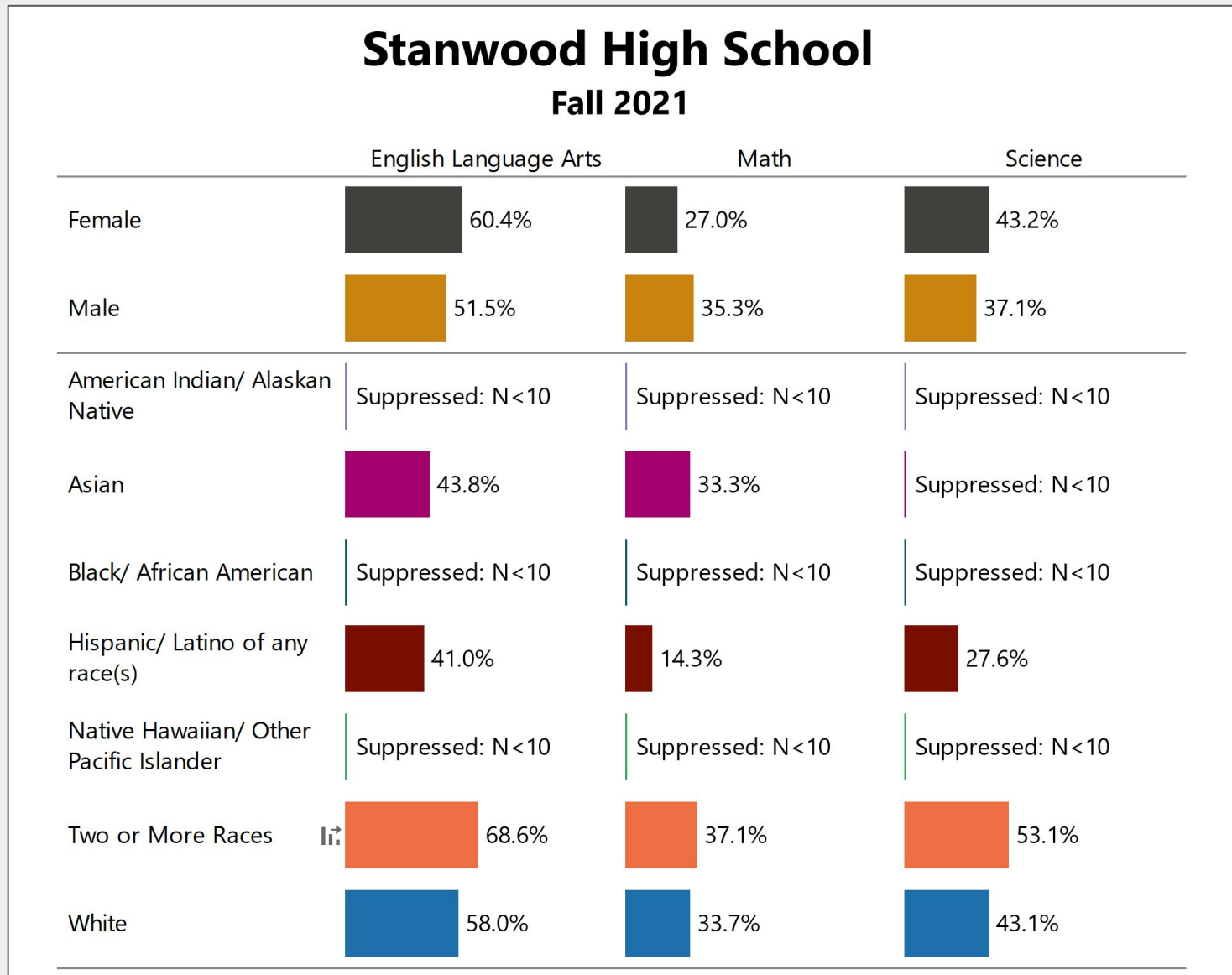

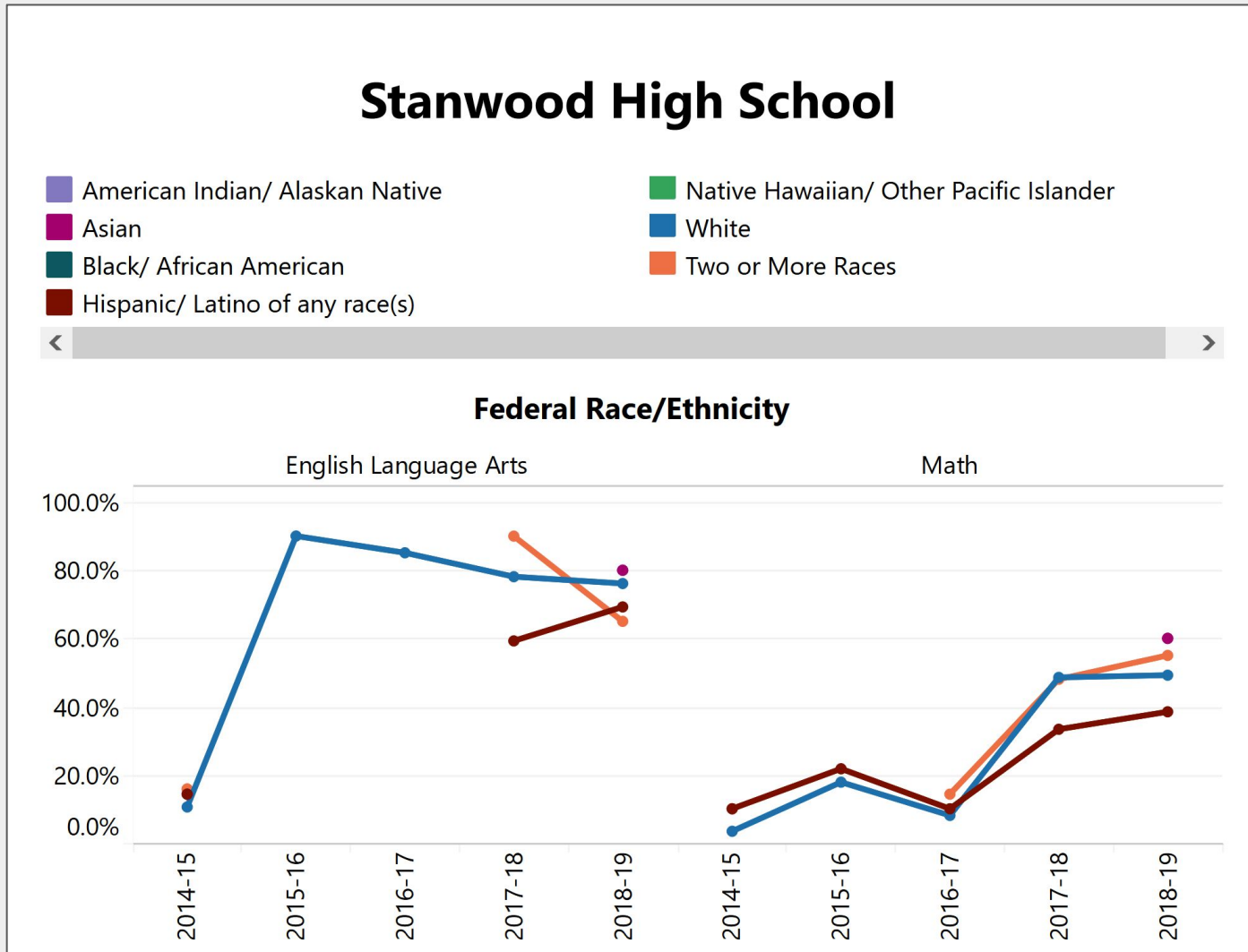

How has student learning grown over time, by demographic?



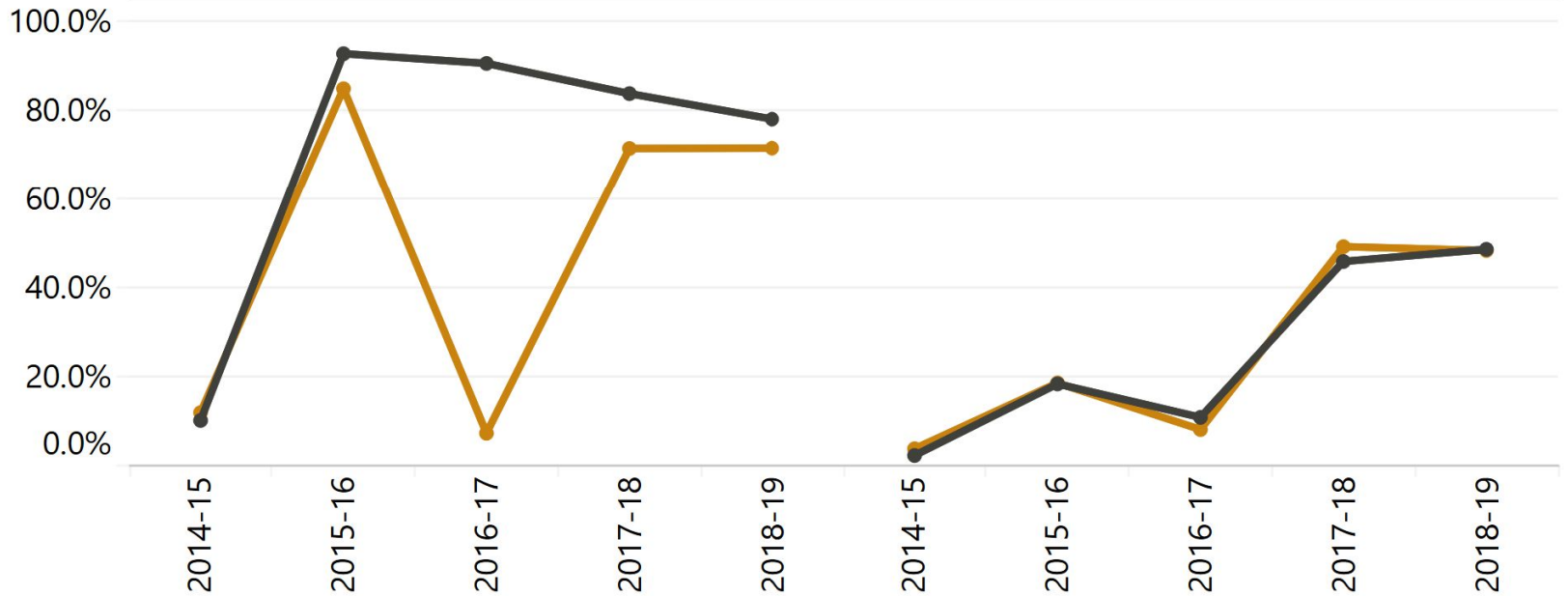

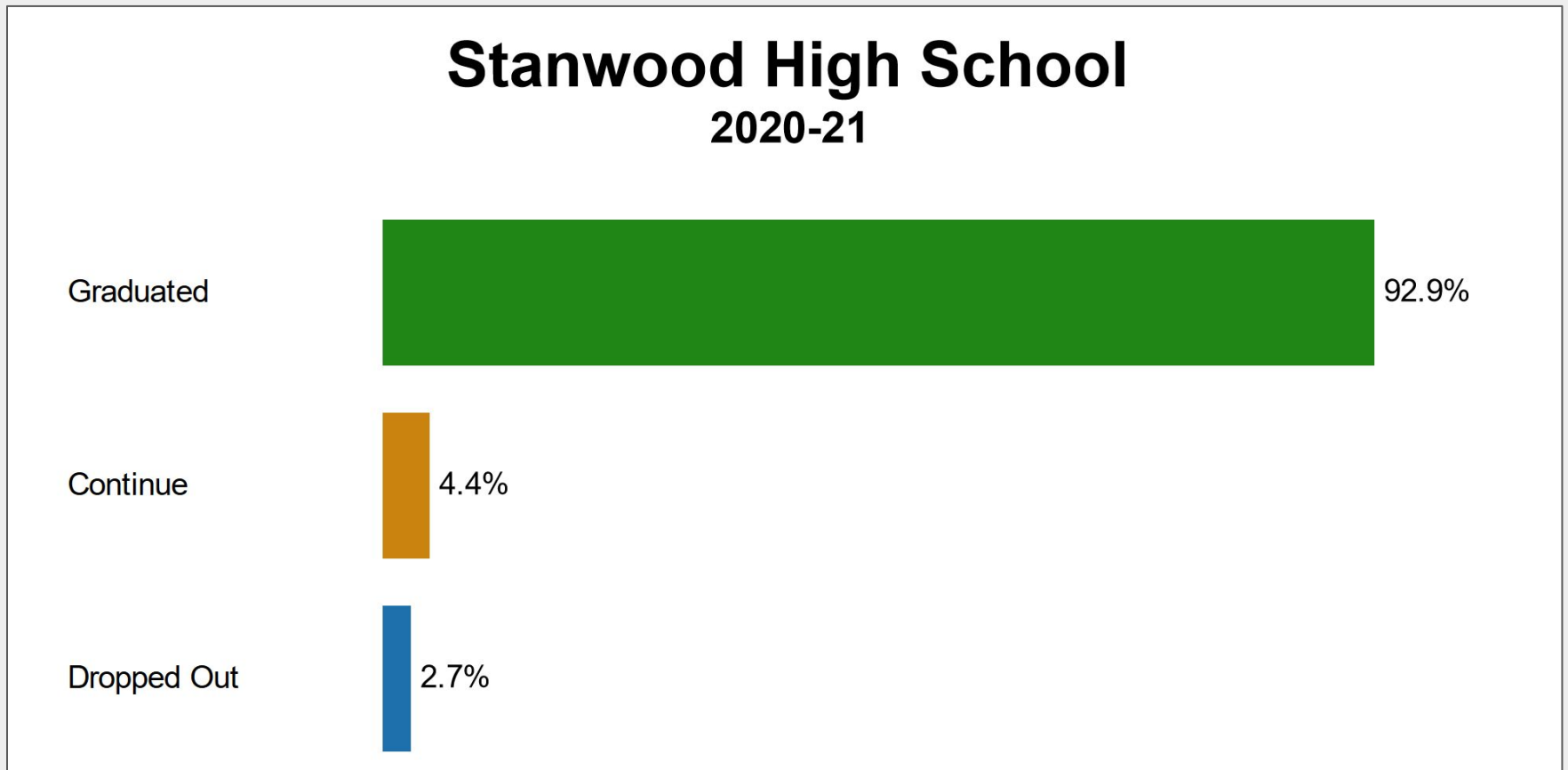

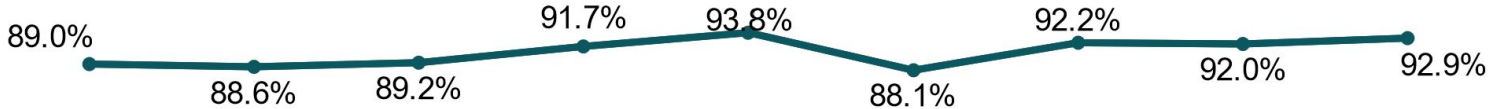


Percent of Students Graduating In 4 Years
